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Guardian Angels Program

The Southampton Rose Society (SRS) is continuing it's Guardian Angel Program (GAP), to help fund the maintenance of the five gardens in Southampton Village that the SRS maintains.

THE GARDENS ARE:

1. Hampton Road next to Town & Country
2. Side of Shippy's Restaurant
3. In Front of the Cultural Center
4. The Rogers Memorial Library Garden
5. Job's Lane beside the restaurant, Bamboo

- Each year a donor can be a Guardian Angel for any one or more of the five SRS Gardens.
- A plaque, with the donor or designee's name will be placed at the garden of his/her choice.
- The cost per garden per year is \$2500.
- The Guardian Angel will be paired with the garden of their choice on a first come, first served basis.
- Therefore, if your first preference has already been taken The Board will assign you to the next available garden, following your numbered preferences.

In the event that more than one donor earmarks the same garden, the designation will be determined by the postmark on the envelope denoting your preferences and check or if you choose to pay electronically via our website: www.southamptonrosesociety.org the designation will be made by the time stamp sent from the website when you make your payment and denote your preferences.
